**PROPOSED INTERVENORS-DEFENDANTS'  
MOTION TO INTERVENE**

Proposed Intervenor-Defendants Audrey Blondin, Esq., Kim Hynes, Tom Sevigny, Connecticut Common Cause and Connecticut Citizens Action Group respectfully move this Court, pursuant to Rule 24 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, for an order granting intervention of right because: (1) the application is timely; (2) the applicants have an interest relating to the property or transaction that is the subject of the action; (3) disposition of the action as a practical matter may impede or impair the applicant's ability to protect that interest; and (4) no existing party adequately represents the applicant's interest. Fed. R. Civ. P. 24(a)(2); *See Brennan v. New York City Bd. of Educ.*, 260 F.3d 123, 128 n. 3 (2d Cir. 2001). In the alternative, Proposed Intervenor-Defendants request that an order granting permissive intervention be granted to allow resolution of the questions of fact and law that this defense has in common with the main case. Fed. R. Civ. P. 24(b)(2).
