COMPLAINT

1. Kelli Stargel, a 2022 congressional candidate, and “Limited Govt for a Stronger Florida Political Committee” — a state PAC in Florida that Stargel established in 2013, which raised over \$2.8 million on her behalf — violated federal campaign finance laws by directing or transferring \$1 million in “soft money” to Conservative Warriors PAC, a federal super PAC that spent virtually all of this money exclusively advancing Stargel’s 2022 candidacy. Moreover, because Stargel thereby directly or indirectly “financed” Conservative Warriors PAC, the super PAC also violated federal campaign finance laws by raising and spending “soft money” in connection with the 2022 election.
2. For over twenty years, the Federal Election Campaign Act (“FECA”) has prohibited federal candidates, along with their agents and entities they establish, finance, maintain, or control, from raising or spending soft money — including, *e.g.*, money raised by

nonfederal committees and organizations that are not subject to federal campaign finance laws — in connection with a federal election. The transfer of \$1,000,000 from a state PAC “directly or indirectly established, financed, maintained, or controlled by or acting on behalf of” Stargel to a federal super PAC that used those funds to support Stargel’s own campaign brazenly violated federal campaign finance laws that are crucial to preventing corruption and ensuring transparency in our federal elections.

3. This complaint is filed pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(1) and is based on information and belief that Stargel, Limited Govt for a Stronger Florida Political Committee, and Conservative Warriors PAC and Brett Doster in his official capacity as treasurer have violated FECA, 52 U.S.C. § 30101, *et seq.* If the Federal Election Commission (“FEC” or “Commission”), “upon receiving a complaint . . . has reason to believe that a person has committed, or is about to commit, a violation of [FECA] . . . [t]he Commission *shall make an investigation* of such alleged violation.”¹

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

4. Kelli Stargel ran for Congress in 2022, filing a statement of candidacy on May 16, 2022.² Her authorized campaign committee, Kelli Stargel for Congress, filed a statement of organization with the Commission the same day.³

5. Conservative Warriors PAC (“CW PAC”) is a federal independent-expenditure only political committee (“IEOPC”), commonly referred to as a “super PAC,” that registered with the Commission on June 2, 2022. CW PAC’s treasurer is Brett Doster.⁴
6. Limited Govt for a Stronger Florida Political Committee (“LGSF PAC”) is a state PAC that registered in Florida on July 12, 2013.⁵ Its chairman and treasurer was Eric Robinson.⁶
7. On May 1, 2014, Stargel filed a “Statement of Solicitation” with respect to LGSF PAC that provided, under “Relationship Between Office Holder or Candidate and Organization” — “Established.”⁷ Stargel does not appear to have ever rescinded or withdrawn this statement of solicitation. Her statement of solicitation discloses that LGSF PAC’s website is “WWW.LIMITEDGOVTSTRONGERFL.COM”, which indicates that LGSF PAC’s only “Associated Legislator/Candidate” is Stargel.⁸
8. Over a nine-year period, LGSF PAC raised a total of \$2,869,825.62 in contributions on Stargel’s behalf.⁹ Among those, LGSF PAC received contributions totaling at least

\$185,000 from federal contractors, *i.e.*, persons that were, at the time of their contributions, performing on or negotiating a contract with a federal department or agency.¹⁰ If the recipient had been a federal committee subject to FECA's jurisdiction, rather than a state PAC generally subject to state law, these contributions would have been prohibited.¹¹

9. LGSF PAC was disbanded on May 19, 2022 — three days after Stargel filed her federal statement of candidacy with the Commission.¹² In a letter acknowledging the committee's termination, the Florida Department of State noted that LGSF PAC would have to submit a final report by June 10, 2022,¹³ but no such report appears to have been submitted.
10. On June 6, 2022 — three weeks after Stargel declared her federal candidacy — CW PAC received a contribution of \$1,000,000 from LGSF PAC.¹⁴ For the 2022 election cycle, LGSF PAC's \$1 million contribution was one of only two itemized contributions that CW PAC received, and it represented over 97% of the IEOPC's total receipts.¹⁵
11. CW PAC reported raising \$1,025,100 and spending \$1,003,954.27 in total during the 2022 election cycle, with over \$946,000 spent on independent expenditures supporting

Stargel’s candidacy or opposing her opponents.¹⁶ CW PAC effectively ceased operations after Stargel was defeated in the 2022 primary election on August 23, 2022.¹⁷

SUMMARY OF THE LAW

12. Under FECA, a “candidate” is defined as “an individual who seeks nomination for election, or election, to Federal office” and crosses the statutory threshold of receiving aggregate contributions, or making aggregate expenditures, in excess of \$5,000.¹⁸
13. Federal candidates must file a written statement designating a principal campaign committee within fifteen days of becoming a candidate.¹⁹
14. FECA requires that the funds federal candidates and officeholders raise and spend in connection with federal elections comply with federal campaign finance laws. The Bipartisan Campaign Reform Act of 2002 (“BCRA”) amended FECA to prohibit federal candidates and officeholders, their agents, and any entities that they directly or indirectly establish, finance, maintain or control from raising or spending funds in connection with a federal election outside of FECA’s contribution limits, source prohibitions, and reporting requirements — *i.e.*, so-called “soft money.”²⁰
15. Specifically, FECA provides, in relevant part:

A candidate, individual holding Federal office, agent of a candidate or an individual holding Federal office, or an entity directly or indirectly established, financed, maintained or controlled by or acting on behalf of 1 or more candidates or individuals holding Federal office, shall not — (A) solicit, receive, direct, transfer, or

spend funds in connection with an election for Federal office, including funds for any Federal election activity, unless the funds are subject to the limitations, prohibitions, and reporting requirements of this Act.²¹

16. As such, FECA prohibits federal candidates and officeholders, their agents, and any entities that they directly or indirectly establish, finance, maintain or control — which includes nonfederal committees not subject to FECA — from soliciting, receiving, directing, or transferring funds in connection with a federal election that are not subject to federal campaign finance laws.
17. Although federal court decisions have invalidated some of FECA’s source prohibitions and amount limitations, as applied to IEOPCs,²² those decisions left intact BCRA’s statutory amendments mandating that federal candidates and officeholders cannot “solicit, receive, direct, transfer, or spend” soft money in connection with federal elections, and those requirements thus remain in effect, as the Commission itself has clearly recognized.
18. In Advisory Opinion 2011-12 (Majority PAC), the Commission explicitly reaffirmed that BCRA, codified at 52 U.S.C. § 30125 *et seq.*, “remains valid” after *Citizens United* and *SpeechNow*: “[BCRA] was enacted by Congress long after [FECA’s] contribution limits and source prohibitions. It was upheld by the Supreme Court in *McConnell v. FEC*, 540 U.S. 93, 181-184 (2003), and remains valid since it was not disturbed by either *Citizens United* or *SpeechNow*.”²³ In that advisory opinion, the Commission stated that federal

candidates cannot lawfully solicit funds on an IEOPC's behalf that are beyond FECA's contribution limits, source prohibitions, and reporting requirements.²⁴

19. In MUR 7853, the Commission applied FECA's soft money prohibitions in the context of soft money transfers to an IEOPC that spent those funds in connection with a federal election: the Commission found reason to believe and conciliated violations of 52 U.S.C. § 30125(e)(1)(A) arising from the transfer of \$126,500 from "Campaign to Elect Lance Harris," a state campaign committee, to Stand for Truth, a federal IEOPC that made independent expenditures supporting Lance Harris's federal candidacy.²⁵
20. Moreover, the Commission also found reason to believe and conciliated a violation of Section 30125(e) by Stand for Truth, the IEOPC that received soft money from Harris's state campaign committee: because Stand for Truth received virtually all of its funding for the 2020 election cycle from Harris's state committee, the IEOPC was "financed" by Harris and violated the law by raising and spending soft money in support of his federal candidacy.²⁶
21. Accordingly, even after *Citizens United* and *SpeechNow*, FECA clearly prohibits federal candidates and officeholders, their agents, and any other entities that they directly or indirectly establish, finance, maintain or control, from directing or transferring

contributions raised outside FECA’s contribution limits and source prohibitions, and/or aggregating more than \$5,000 per year, to an IEOPC.²⁷

CAUSES OF ACTION

COUNT I:

STARGEL AND LGSF PAC VIOLATED 52 U.S.C. § 30125(E)(1)(A) BY DIRECTING OR TRANSFERRING SOFT MONEY TO CW PAC IN CONNECTION WITH THE 2022 ELECTION

22. The available information supports finding reason to believe that Stargel, a federal candidate, and LGSF PAC, a nonfederal committee “directly or indirectly established, financed, maintained or controlled by or acting on behalf of” Stargel, violated FECA by directing or transferring \$1 million, either directly or through an agent, from LGSF PAC to CW PAC in connection with the 2022 election.²⁸
23. LGSF PAC is a nonfederal committee, a state PAC registered in Florida, that Stargel, in official statements filed with Florida authorities, acknowledged that she “established” and authorized to raise funds on her behalf.²⁹ Stargel filed a statement of solicitation on May 1, 2014, which acknowledged that her “relationship” to the organization was that she had “established” LGSF PAC.³⁰ Stargel does not appear to have ever rescinded or withdrawn that statement, which authorized LGSF PAC to raise money on her behalf. Over a nine-year period from its formation in 2013 to its disbandment on May 19, 2022 — just three days after Stargel declared her federal candidacy — LGSF PAC raised over \$2.8 million “on behalf of” Stargel.³¹

24. The foregoing facts, viewed together, support finding reason to believe LGSF PAC was “an entity directly or indirectly established, financed, maintained, or controlled by or acting on behalf of” Stargel under FECA and FEC regulations.³²
25. On June 6, 2022, three weeks after Stargel declared herself a federal candidate by filing a statement of candidacy and registering an authorized campaign committee with the Commission, LGSF PAC directed or transferred \$1,000,000 to CW PAC, a federal IEOPC.³³ CW PAC, in turn, subsequently spent over \$946,000 supporting Stargel’s 2022 federal candidacy.³⁴
26. As a state PAC registered in Florida, raising funds subject only to Florida law, none of the money that LGSF PAC raised was subject to FECA’s contribution limits, source prohibitions, and reporting requirements. Indeed, at least \$185,000 raised by CW PAC appears to have come from federal contractors, such that those contributions would have been prohibited under FECA if they had been made to federal committees.³⁵
27. Based on the foregoing, there is reason to believe that Stargel and LGSF PAC, “an entity directly or indirectly established, financed, maintained, or controlled by or acting on behalf of” Stargel, violated 52 U.S.C. § 30125(e)(1)(A) by directing or transferring — either directly or through an agent — \$1 million that did not comply with FECA’s contribution limits, source prohibitions, and reporting requirements in connection with a federal election.

COUNT II:
**CW PAC VIOLATED 52 U.S.C. § 30125(E)(1)(A) BY RAISING AND SPENDING
SOFT MONEY IN CONNECTION WITH THE 2022 ELECTION**

28. The available information supports finding reason to believe that CW PAC was also “directly or indirectly established, financed, maintained, or controlled by or acting on behalf of” Stargel under FECA,³⁶ such that CW PAC also violated the law by raising and spending soft money — *i.e.*, making over \$946,000 in independent expenditures advancing Stargel’s candidacy — in connection with the 2022 election.
29. As noted above, CW PAC received \$1 million from LGSF PAC, “an entity directly or indirectly established, financed, maintained, or controlled by or acting on behalf of” Stargel.³⁷ CW PAC reported raising \$1,025,100 and spending \$1,003,954.27 in total during the 2022 election cycle, with over \$946,000 spent on independent expenditures supporting Stargel or opposing her electoral opponents.³⁸ As such, for the 2022 election cycle, LGSF PAC’s \$1 million contribution constituted over 97% of CW PAC’s total receipts, all of which appear to have been spent in connection with the 2022 election.³⁹
30. Under FEC regulations, the Commission determines whether a federal candidate or officeholder directly or indirectly established, financed, maintained, or controlled an entity after examining a non-exhaustive list of affiliation factors set forth at 11 C.F.R. § 300.2(c)(2), including:

Whether a sponsor, directly or through its agent, *provides funds or goods in a significant amount* or on an ongoing basis to the entity, such as through direct or indirect payments for administrative, fundraising, or other costs[; or] Whether a sponsor, directly or through its agent, *causes or arranges for funds in a significant amount* or on an ongoing basis *to be provided* to the entity[.]⁴⁰

31. As the previous section explains, there is reason to believe Stargel, a federal candidate, directly or indirectly established, financed, maintained, or controlled LGSF PAC, and, as such, if LGSF PAC “provid[ed] funds . . . in a significant amount” to another entity, that entity — here, CW PAC — would in turn also be “directly or indirectly established, financed, maintained, or controlled by” Stargel.
32. LGSF PAC’s \$1 million contribution to CW PAC, which comprised *virtually all* of the IEOPC’s funding, was indisputably “a significant amount” of funds provided to the IEOPC.⁴¹ Accordingly, there is reason to believe Stargel, a federal candidate, directly or indirectly “financed” CW PAC through LGSF PAC.⁴²
33. In turn, there is reason to believe that when CW PAC spent LGSF PAC’s money — all of it nonfederal funds, including at least \$185,000 in federal contractor contributions, which did not comport with FECA’s requirements — to either pay its operating costs or make independent expenditures supporting Stargel or opposing her opponents in the 2022 election, CW PAC raised and spent “soft money” in connection with a federal election, in violation of 52 U.S.C. § 30125(e)(1)(A).⁴³

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

34. Wherefore, the Commission should find reason to believe that Stargel, LGSF PAC, and CW PAC violated 52 U.S.C. § 30101 *et seq.*, and conduct an immediate investigation under 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(2).
35. Further, the Commission should seek appropriate sanctions for any and all violations, including civil penalties sufficient to deter future violations, injunctive relief to remedy these violations and prohibit any and all future violations, and such additional remedies as are necessary and appropriate to ensure compliance with FECA.


