DEFENDANTS' DESIGNATION OF COUNSEL FOR DECEMBER 4-5 ARGUMENT

Pursuant to the Court's Order of November 15, 2002, defendants submit the attached designations of arguing counsel, the issues each counsel will address, and the length of each counsel's argument. Attached first is a set of designations based on the schedule for oral argument set out in the Court's November 15 Order.

The plaintiffs and defendants have conferred, however, and now join in a request for a slight adjustment of the schedule set forth under the Court's Order. This modification would not add to the total time provided for argument, but the parties agree that it would allow counsel to present argument more effectively on the important issues raised in this case.

The adjustment sought by the parties is two-fold. First, they request that the Court permit argument of the coordination issues (BCRA §§ 202, 213, 214), now set to take place as part of the Title II argument on Wednesday, December 4, 2002, be combined with the argument of the Title III issues on Thursday, December 5. To accommodate the addition of the coordination issues, the parties further ask that ten minutes per side be reallocated from the Title V/lowest unit charge argument to the proposed Title III/coordination argument.
