BACKGROUND:

The National Shooting Sports Foundation (NSSF) is the leading trade association of the firearms and recreational shooting sports industry. (see attached backgrounder). The gun manufacturers are in the midst of various legal actions by the Clinton administration (see attached articles,

especially op-ed piece by Chambers).

The NSSF contacted the RNC about making a contribution of significance about two weeks ago. Their board approved the two contributions within the last week.
