## ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANTS' MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION CONCERNING DEPOSITIONS OF EXPERT WITNESSES (September 19, 2002)

These consolidated cases are before the Court upon the defendants' Motion for Clarification Concerning Depositions of Expert Witnesses, dated September 18, 2002. The Court having considered the motion—as well as its own order of July 26, 2002—it is this /1 day of September 2002 hereby

ORDERED that the defendants' Motion for Clarification [#15\$ is GRANTED.

It is further

ORDERED that, pursuant to the Court's order of July 26, 2002, the parties are not permitted to conduct depositions of expert witnesses but may cross-examine experts following the submission of their expert reports (whether affirmative, rebuttal, or both). Such examination may include the subject matter of the experts' reports and any other matter falling within the scope of permissible discovery. It is further

ORDERED that all notices of depositions of experts previously served in this action and not in compliance with this order are hereby QUASHED.
